The Managing Director, as the person accountable for safety is entrusted with ensuring that the necessary organisation and resource is provided for this policy and its objectives to be implemented effectively. Care for individual needs is to be extended to care for the environment and, accordingly, the company's operations will be conducted to minimize ecological damage to the environment so far as is reasonably practicable. Wherever possible, materials used in support of the company's business shall be those, which present the least risk to the health of personnel and the ecology of the environment, whilst adequately and safely fulfilling the needs of the task being performed.

Unsafe acts and environmentally damaging procedures are neither efficient nor, in the long term, cost effective. Health, Safety and Environmental matters will therefore have equal status with other primary business objectives and consideration of these factors will directly contribute to improved efficiency and success of the business unit.

Kraken Offshore Ltd recognises that its employees play an important role in safety and requests that all personnel and subcontractors at any work site fulfill their statutory obligations by adhering to written work instructions at all times, reporting all unsafe conditions immediately and recognizing that they have a legal duty to ensure that they take reasonable care for their own health and safety and that of colleagues who may be affected by their negligence.

From time to time, specialist advice will be obtained on safety and environmental affairs. The directors will ensure that this safety policy is being adhered to at all times and that the stated objectives are met.
