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Drug and Alcohol Policy

1.0 Kraken Offshore Ltd Drugs and Alcohol Policy Statement

Kraken Offshore Ltd is committed to creating and maintaining a safe workplace for all shore based, shipboard, Project and other stakeholder personnels. In doing so Kraken Offshore Ltd has adopted the Oil Companies International Marine Forum (OCIMF) Guidelines for the control of drugs and alcohol on board ships.

Kraken Offshore Ltd operates a zero tolerance regime for all occasions whereby:

- An employee is consuming alcohol and/or prohibited substances (incl. cannabis) whilst performing scheduled duties;
- An employee is under influence of drugs or alcohol whilst performing scheduled duties;
- An employee misuses legitimate drugs, or possesses, uses, distributes or sells illicit or unprescribed drugs;
- An employee takes on board any alcohol;
- An employee is abusing the use of alcohol, exceeding legally permitted levels of blood or urine alcohol concentration, whilst being on board a vessel, on work or project premises and whilst traveling to or from a project location.

Where it is suspected that an employee may be in violation of the either Kraken Offshore Ltd or project Company's drugs and alcohol policy, they shall be denied access to the vessel, site or project location.

This Drugs and Alcohol Policy Statement is endorsed by Kraken Offshore Ltd Management Team and will be continually reviewed periodically. It will be systematically adopted by all Kraken Offshore Ltd personnel and associates. The Drugs and Alcohol Policy Statement will be made readily available to all interested relevant parties upon request and permanently through our website.
